OUR MEMBERS ASK

We've heard that there is legislation being proposed that would provide grants for code enforcement and blight prevention? What's the latest news on this program?

House Bill 273 introduced in the spring session of 2025 provides for DCED competitive grants to municipalities to establish code enforcement programs and to hire code enforcement personnel to help address blighted property conditions. Currently, COGs are not included as eligible applicants for this program. Since many COGs provide code enforcement services to their member municipalities, we would encourage you to work with your state representatives to insert language that would allow COGs to be eligible applicants should this legislation become law.
